



Home Learning Plan

The CKS home learning plan is designed to provide students with standards based and developmentally appropriate instruction during the designated home learning period (currently scheduled for 3/18-3/27).

Weekly learning modules will provide your student with opportunities to learn new material, engage in project based learning, practice/apply skills already learned, develop independence/self-discipline, complete enrichment activities, read for pleasure, and hone his/her computer skills.

CKS Home Learning Plan Specifics

- The CKS home learning plan will begin on Wednesday, 3/18.
- Teachers will post two learning modules to Class Dojo (grades K-2) or Google Classroom (grades 3-8).

- Homeroom teachers will post an attendance recorder by 8:00am every morning. Students are asked to submit their attendance by 12:00pm every day.
- If your student is sick, please email the attendance office at attendance@christking.org. You do not need to email your student's homeroom teacher. Students will be allowed to make up missed work, regardless of the reason they are absent.
- Teachers will engage in school related activities Monday-Friday from 8:00-3:00pm and conduct virtual office hours Monday-Friday from 1:00-3:00pm. Teachers will be available during this window via Google Classroom for students and via Class Dojo and CKS email for parents.

General Curriculum Information

- Per an Archdiocesan directive, teachers are assigning work equal to a half-day of school (total- not per subject). Accordingly, teachers are reducing required minute requirements per subject area by approximately 50%. Enrichment teachers are assigning one lesson per week.
- Library time will be defined as DEAR (Drop Everything And Read) time during the home learning period. Students in grades 2-8 will be able to take Accelerated Reader tests as well.
- Students will meet the technology requirement by participating in the home learning program, so no assignments will be given.
- Teachers ARE NOT posting assignments/assessments on Plus Portals. Faculty will only use Plus Portals to send emails and post grades. Use Google Classroom and Class Dojo to access weekly learning modules.
