Dear CKS parents,

Our teachers have been busy at work preparing a unique learning opportunity for your children. This letter outlines the CKS Home Learning Plan process explaining the:

1. Digital classrooms
2. Credentials information
3. Home Learning Plan

Digital Classrooms

- All students have been enrolled in their digital classrooms.
- Grades K-2: Class Dojo is the digital classroom of choice; it is your child's platform for receiving instruction.
- Grades 3-8: Google Classroom is the digital classroom of choice; it is your child's platform for receiving instruction.

Credentials Information

Class Dojo (Grades K-2)

- Grades K-1 have been using Class Dojo this year; grades K-1, you are ready to go.
- Many grade 2 families are already enrolled in Class Dojo from previous years.
- If any grade 2 parents were not in Class Dojo, then you should have recently received a Class Dojo request from your child's teacher under a separate email. If you have NOT received this request, then email your teacher-your first point of contact for Class Dojo.

Google Classroom (Grades 3-8)

- **Grades K-2 do not need Google Classroom information, as it is not needed for Class Dojo.**
- **Please continue to Renaissance Place.**
- Grades 3-8 need to sign into their Google account. You received your student's information in a separate email. Contact cksadministration@christking.org for help.
 - Password:
 - Grades 3-4: Students use the Generic Student Password that has been provided by his/her teacher.
 - Grades 5-8: Students use their CKS network password (same one used when signing in on school device)
- **IMPORTANT: If you have multiple students in your household using Google Classroom on the SAME device, then each student MUST completely log out of one account in order to get into another account. Check the Google dashboard to confirm child's log-in initial or icon.**
- You need to be in your Google account to enter your Google Classroom. Choose

- the waffle icon for Google Apps next to your child's initial. Choose Google Classroom.
- You will see all the classrooms in which your child is enrolled.
- Mr. Barletta has prepared a Google sign-in tutorial, specifically addressing multiple users on same device. This is located on the CKS website's Home Learning Plan page.

Renaissance Place (Accelerated Reader: Grades 2-8)

Students may continue taking AR tests during the Home Learning period.

- The link is also on the top of Mr. Barletta's website: mrbarletta.com
 - Click "I'm a Student" to get to the log-in screen.
 - Enter username and password.
 - You received your student's information in a separate email. Contact cksadministration@christking.org for help.
 - Password
 - Grades K - 4: star
 - Grades 5 - 8: use your CKS network password (same one you use when signing in on your school device)
 - Once signed in, your child needs to choose "Accelerated Reader" to continue.
 - If your child does not remember his/her password, then please send an email to cksadministration@christking.org

BrainPOP

- If your child's teacher is using BrainPOP, then the teacher will reach out to you with further instructions, if necessary.
- If multiple children have been assigned a BrainPOP assignment, then please check the BrainPOP dashboard to confirm the correct child is logged into the account.
- If you have trouble logging in to BrainPOP, then please submit your request to cksadministration@christking.org
- **If you have trouble getting past the sign-in screen, then try signing in to BrainPOP through another browser (Try: Firefox, Safari, Edge, etc.)**

Moby Max

- If your child's teacher is using Moby Max, then the teacher will reach out to you with further instructions, if necessary.
- If you have trouble logging in to Moby Max, then please submit your request to cksadministration@christking.org

IXL

- If your child's teacher is using IXL, then the teacher will reach out to you with further instructions, if necessary.
- If you have trouble logging in to IXL, then please email your teacher-your first point of contact for IXL.
